

Data Warehouse Data Collection Summary

Human Resources Biographic/Demographic Data – Biographic data (name, address, telephone), demographic data (race/ethnicity, gender, citizenship, age, visa status), self-reported data (prior education, prior degrees, prior jobs, licenses and certifications, honors and awards, publications and skills), employment status, campus code and identifiers (Social Security number-restricted use, University Identification Number).

Human Resources and Payroll – Time and attendance, benefits, deductions, payroll, job and position information, faculty rank and tenure information.

Finance Data – Accounts payable, purchasing, accounts receivable, cash, general ledger, CFOAPAL listings, encumbrances, reservations, expense, revenue, fixed assets, grants.

HR/Finance Budget - Data from both the Banner Finance and Human Resources budget modules to provide an integrated view of Finance data and HR data at different levels of detail, from account level to department position level. Includes budget codes, charts, fiscal year codes, employee class codes, jobs detail, CFOAPAL distributions,

Catalog and Schedule – Course set up and restrictions, section set up and restrictions, meeting rooms, building records and instructor assignments.

Financial Aid - Aid application and need analysis data, financial aid funds and awards (including disbursement), loan application and processing, satisfactory academic progress data, student employment data, financial aid holds

Pre-Registration & Registration - Enrollment, adds, drops, deletes, withdrawals, enrollment stop-outs and graduation time limits, assessment of tuition and fees, grades, immunization, holds, new student orientation, special populations

Recruiting & Admissions – Curriculum, student type/level and residency, attributes, how they learned about UI, recruit status, recruiter information, checklists and interviews, admissions ratings and decisions, decision status.

Registration Census - A series of specific university official dates needed for census reporting, analysis of general student record, review of student registration activity, analysis of financial aid awards

Records and Transfer Articulation - Calculated Class, Academic Standing, Dean's List, Cohort, Primary and Secondary Degree information, Campus and College Honors, Degree/Level/Term GPA, Transcript information, Course detail including Accepted Transfer Coursework and Institutional Coursework.
